- Harvest and reap vegetables, fruits and crops using farm equipment or hand.
- Perform and execute maintenance and repair of fences and farm buildings.
- Drive and operate farm tractors to bush hoe and make hay.
- Flexible while working in shift.

- Technically skilled to work with machineries used in agriculture.
- Computer literate.
